- 1. The Little Wiz Fire Museum - Home of the Stuff!**
326 East Smith Rd, Medina, Ohio 44256
1916 Hallock Chemical fire truck, hand & horse-drawn fire equipment (from 1850), bells, nozzles, extinguishers, pumps, breathing apparatus, alarm equipment, uniforms, fire grenades, Historical Medina photos and information and lots more stuff!
- 2. Medina Town Hall & Engine House Museum**
50 Public Square, Medina, Ohio 44256
A museum of the history of the Village and City of Medina from the early 1800's through today, with rare images of the Great Fire of 1870, a real 1918 Medina fire engine, hundreds of photos and extensive historical information.
- 3. Medina County Historical Society**
206 North Elmwood, Medina, Ohio 44256
Visit a Queen Anne Victorian house with period furnishings and artifacts. Displays feature clothing, county business and leisure time activities, Civil War, Pioneer and Native American tools and objects.

- McDowell-Phillips House Museum**
205 South Prospect St, Medina 44256
A new and unique collection reflecting the contributions of one of our most historic and influential families in Medina County. The house spans 5 generations and is an excellent sample of Queen Anne Shingle style home.
- 4. York Historical Society**
6547 Spellman St, Medina, Ohio 44256
Historical complex in Mallet Creek: one-room schoolhouse, post and beam barn and granary. Exhibits include school desks, books, maps, records, artifacts, early farm tools, horse-drawn Carriages, restored barn looms and early road grader.

- 5. Litchfield Historical Society**
9268 Norwalk Rd, Litchfield, Ohio 44253
To preserve and share the history of Litchfield Township. An 1846 restored Greek Revival House. The Museum was once the hottest speakeasy in Medina County! Not really, but come in and see our cool stuff just the same!
